MNO Employment in Energy Project INDIGENOUS WOMEN IN TRADES

This is a fully funded 8-month training program with an 8-week work placement in Pre-Trades for the energy industry for Ontario self-identified Indigenous participants, with a focus on women. The next session will begin in September, 2018.

TRAINING PROVIDED IN AN ENERGY-SECTOR FIELD,
SUCH AS BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- **Electrical Techniques**
- **Welding Techniques**
- **Industrial Maintenance Techniques**

Following in-class training, participants proceed to paid work placements with partners in the energy industry. Work placements will provide the vital experience to continue on in skilled trades and/or employment.

THIS GREAT OPPORTUNITY INCLUDES:

- **Career counselling and resume support from Métis Nation of Ontario and partners**
- **Expenses eligible for coverage include: tuition; books and supplies; safety equipment; living allowances; dependent care and travel**
- **Training is open to Métis, First Nations and Inuit people, with a focus on women**

Training is open to self-identified Indigenous participants, with a focus on women.
