The Special Education Resource Teacher (SERT) advocates for and facilitates special education programs and services for students at Kikendaasogamig as per relevant legislation and the Chippewas of Nawash Unceded First Nation Board of Education Policies and Procedures. In collaboration with the Principal, the school team and Board designate, the SERT coordinates and provides special education programs and services, assists with program development and evaluation, and supports curriculum implementation in the school. The teacher shall have an understanding of Anishinaabe heritage and promote Anishinaabemowin, culture, tradition and history as part of the curriculum.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor of Education with an applicable undergraduate degree or Aboriginal Teacher's Diploma
- Registration with the Ontario College of Teachers
- Completion of Special Education qualifications parts I, II and III
- Three (3) year's successful teaching experience with First Nation students, schools or communities
- Successful candidate must provide results of current Children's Aid Society, Police Record and Vulnerable Sector checks and provide a current T.B. test.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS and ABILITIES:

- Current knowledge of curriculum policies, procedures, legislation, needs development and practices for special education delivery in First Nation communities
- Knowledge and understanding of Anishinaabe heritage to promote Anishinaabe heritage, language, culture, tradition and history as part of the curriculum
- Ability to design, organize and implement special needs programming
- Knowledge of special educational testing, Individual Education Plan (IEP) requirements and ability to coordinate applicable student servicing
- Ability to provide leadership in curriculum, classroom and school and team management, and be familiar with community, culturally-based schools
- Experience in human resource management as it relates to teaching and support staff
- Ability to maintain a professional code of ethics and maintain confidentiality
- Ability to coordinate school team in order to develop effective programming, and to initiate requests for formal assessments, consultations and referrals on behalf of students with special needs within the school
- Acts as the primary contact for the flow of all information pertaining to students with special needs within the school
