Among other duties, he is coordinating consultation between SON and Bruce National Park and Fathom Five Marine Park.

Parks Canada and SON have initiated discussions on the future of both National Parks and we'll be working on management plans for both Parks. Parks Canada must do this in consultation with us.

The Parks' management plans must respect the rights of the Saugeen Ojibway Nation. These include our right to harvest, access to the land, and our affirmed commercial fishing rights. The Plans for both parks will be subject to the outcome of the land claim.

The first of many conversations between the Parks and our communities starts ...

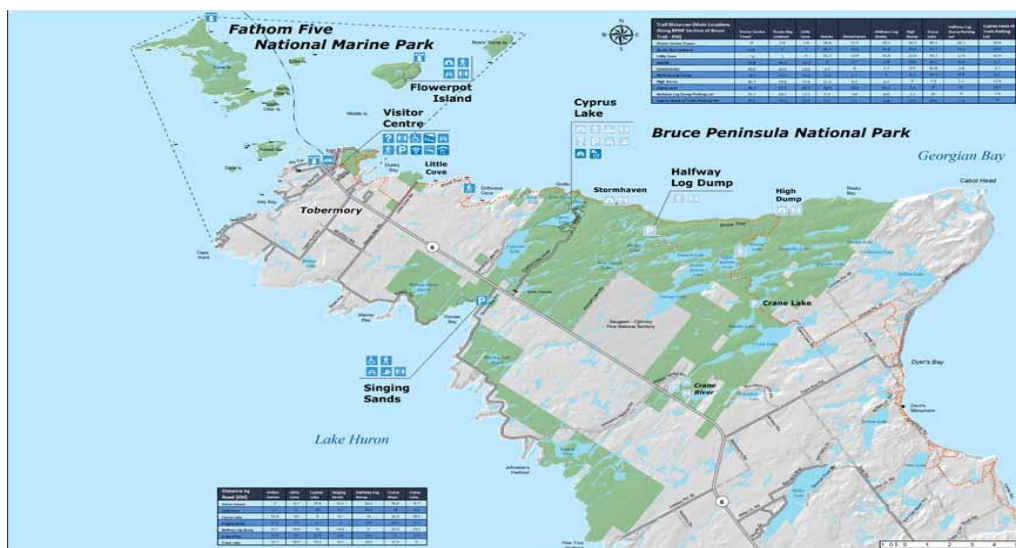
Wednesday, December 5th at the Warton Arena, 526 Taylor Street.
