

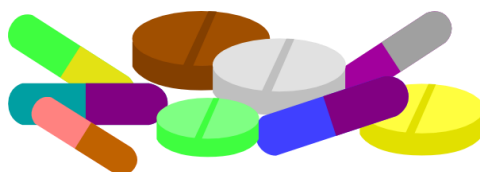
Pregnancy & Opioids
