Court Etiquette and Procedures

The Superior Court has established etiquette and procedures for Justice proceedings. The formal etiquette and procedures have been relaxed to take on more of a community feeling.

While it is customary for our communities to have children participate in our community activities, we ask that only children 16 years and older attend these Hearings.

It is important that there are no distractions while the Hearings are in session. Therefore, we ask that you observe the following:

- Be on time. People entering and exiting the courtroom can be incredibly distracting, you may be required to wait outside of the Rec. Centre until there is an appropriate break in the proceedings
- Turn off your cell phone or any other devices before entering the Rec. Centre. Members of the public are not permitted to use electronic devices (e.g. cell phones, cameras, recording devices, etc.) in the Rec. Centre unless the presiding Judge orders otherwise.
- When the Judge enters the Rec. Centre everyone must rise to show respect, for those who can physically do so. Please rise and remain standing until the Registrar invites you to be seated.
- Please remain silent throughout the proceedings. If you need to speak to someone, please step outside of the courtroom.
- Food and beverages will not be allowed in the courtroom(s).
- Hats or headwear are not permitted except for religious reasons. Please also remove your sunglasses before entering the courtroom, unless they are required due to medical necessity.
- Please do not lean on the chair in front of you or put your feet on the chairs.
- The Judge will determine the timing of the lunch, as well as the morning and afternoon breaks.

Court staff are responsible for maintaining security and decorum in the courtroom. Please comply with any direction that they give you. If you fail to comply with any such direction you may be asked to leave the Rec. Centre.
