**PLEASE NOTE** that any Eligible Elector may nominate or second candidates by using a mail-in nomination form and voter declaration **OR** you may nominate or second candidates in person at the nomination meeting.

Nomination forms and completed, signed and witnessed voter declaration forms **MUST BE RECEIVED** by the Chief Electoral Officer before

the time set for the nomination meeting **OR** you may nominate or second candidates orally at the nomination meeting.

Nomination documents and the official Voters List of all Eligible Electors shall be posted and available during regular business hours at the Saugeen First Nation Band Office; can be requested from the Electoral Officer; and will be available to download at:
