Ontario Implements Provincewide Emergency Brake

As of April 3, 2021, the Province of Ontario will begin a provincewide emergency brake, to continue for at least 4 weeks.

COVID-19 [enhanced public health and workplace safety measures](#) will be in effect in Saugeen First Nation (SFN) during this 4-week period.

SFN band offices and programs will remain open, but all enquiries must call for an appointment with any program or administration staff. SFN residents are asked to diligently follow all pandemic protocols.

On the advice of the [Chief Medical Officer of Health](#), all Ontarians are asked to limit trips outside the home to necessities such as food, medication, medical appointments, supporting vulnerable community members, or exercising outdoors with members of their household. Thus, all non-residents are asked to respect the above recommendations and remain at their homes, away from SFN.

Your patience and understanding regarding this Provincewide Emergency Brake process is greatly appreciated.
