SAUGEEN FIRST NATION COVID UPDATE FOR JULY 16TH, 2021

On Monday, July 19, 2021, SFN Chief and Council will meet with local Grey Bruce Health professionals to discuss **next steps for a plan of action**, about **lifting some of the community lockdown measures** currently in place.

Until then, **current community lockdown measures in place will remain as is**, until a formal update is provided following the next SFN Chief and Council meeting on Monday.

We are asking **all non-essential staff to continue working from home** until notified otherwise by their supervisor.

We will **continue to post the daily COVID statistics everyday** on our SFN Facebook and website.

Beginning next week, we will only be providing **one video update once a week**.

Finally, please stay home, travel only unless it's necessary, **avoid group gatherings** outside your home, and strictly observe the following pandemic protocols:

- ✓ Wear a mask outside your home.
- ✓ Wash your hands frequently.
- ✓ Watch your distance and remain at least 2 meters from people you don't live with.
