## SAUGEEN FIRST NATION COVID UPDATE FOR AUGUST 25<sup>TH</sup>, 2021

As of August 25<sup>th</sup>, there are two active cases of COVID-19 in Saugeen First Nation. As of today, one of these cases will be cleared leaving only one active case.

Please continue to follow COVID-19 safeguards and protocols to protect yourself and your community from COVID-19. Please see the current guidelines below:

- ✓ Wear a mask when indoors and when social distancing isn't an option (including when outdoors)
- ✓ Socially distance when possible (stay 2m apart)
- ✓ Avoid gatherings with people outside of your household unless all COVID-19 safety protocols can be followed (social distancing, wearing a mask, etc.)
- ✓ Wash hands frequently and use hand sanitizer often
- ✓ Disinfect common touch surfaces
- ✓ Avoid touching your face
