Title: Social Worker Position (x2)
Reports to: Transitional House Coordinator

Hours: 35 hours per week (Flexible hours)

Location: Transitional Home

Position Summary: This position will oversee the Transitional Home Support Workers and work collaboratively with the Transitional House Coordinator.

Duties:

- Reporting to Immediate Supervisor the Transitional House Coordinator
- Will implement and monitor services to meet the needs of individuals with significant mental health and addictions needs following Recovery Principles.
- The Social Worker must be able to function independently and as a member of a multidisciplinary team and work cooperatively with multiple service providers
- This position requires travel throughout the catchment area (Grey and Bruce Counties) to deliver programs and to meet the needs of clients.
- Responsibility for a case management caseload is required.
- This position is initially targeted to work in the Addiction Treatment Programs both Internal and External agencies
- Guide and support the Transitional House Support Workers
- Implement programs within the Transitional House

- **Qualifications:**
- Degree in Nursing, Social Work, Psychology or a related health or Social Science field
- Current registration in good standing with the College of Psychotherapists of Ontario, or the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers
- Experience in management
- Experience working in a transitional house
- Minimum 5 years recent experience working in the community with individuals with significant mental health and addictions needs
- Knowledge of the Mental Health Act and familiarity with DSM-V
- Training and experience in Brief Solution-Focused Therapy
- Training and experience in Cognitive Behavioural Therapy
- Training and experience in Single Session Therapy
- Training and experience in Group therapy
- Training and experience in Dialectical Behavior Therapy
- Knowledge and appreciation of Recovery Principles
- Knowledge of side effects of medication and strategies to cope with those side effects
- C.P.I. training up to date
- C.P.R. – basic certification
- Valid Ontario Class ‘G’ driver’s license and access to reliable transportation – traveling will be required
- Proven ability to work cooperatively in a team setting
- Able to be on call, work flexible hours, including weekends
- Recent satisfactory performance and attendance records
- Work Collaboratively with other referral departments
