The main pick-up location will be the Band Office lobby on Tuesday January 11th, from 1-4pm and Thursday January 13th from 1-4pm. Please make sure to wear your mask (even outside if you're around others), sanitize your hands on entry to the building, social distance from others (even if waiting outside) and only allow for one person in the lobby at a time.

The Health Centre will also have some available to give out to individuals attending clinics or appointments this week – please do not go to the Health Centre just to get the test kits.

From now on we will continue to get swabs into the community on a regular basis, but we ask that each household does not take more than they need at this time.
