RE: Sauble Park (South Sauble Beach) Beach Closure

June 30, 2022

The portion of Saugeen First Nation#29 Beach, known as Sauble Park, is closed to the general public at this time. Sauble Park starts from Main St. Sauble Beach, ON and extends 4.2km south to French Bay Rd. There are to be no motorized vehicles on the beach, with the exception of emergency vehicles and some service vehicles. With the closure, the beach is still accessible for Saugeen Ojibway Nation members and those who have cottage leases with Saugeen First Nation#29. For SON members, drop off at entrances is allowed but when parking on side streets please be sure to not block road allowances or driveways.
