Re: Call for Expressions of Interest

In consideration of the ongoing drug epidemic which introduces criminality, violence and contributes to the tragic loss of lives, the Council of Saugeen First Nation has issued a Declaration of State of Emergency, effective <u>December 8th, 2022</u>

In response to the State of Emergency, the Council of Saugeen First Nation will convene a Community Safety Task Force ('Task Force') which will bring together a diverse group of interdisciplinary subject matter experts and community members to assist inform a collaborative approach related to concerns from community members around drugs, gangs, and weapons.

The Task Force is interested to onboard six (6) community members (comprised equally of youth, adults, and Elders).
