Eligible students must have proof of Indigenous Identity and be planning to take a minimum full time two-year program or a full-time four-year program.

Best of all, it's renewable!

That's right: students could receive up to \$10,000 if they keep a full-time course load. Check this out today please – **the deadline is March 1, 2023!**
