• Governance Capacity Planning

Initiate community engagement, consultation, and ratification on Core Functions of Nation Governance

- As <u>each</u> Core Function of Nation Governance is completed (following engagement, consultation, and review), there will be a scheduled community ratification (vote).
- Community ratification is important as each Core Function will be binding on Council. With Council representative
 of the electorate, it is important that the community assist to inform a governance framework.
- Upon ratification, endorsed Core Functions will form part of a Governance Framework (Law) that will guide Council and Administration.
- Proposed ratification threshold is under review.
- **UPDATE**: Application submitted for recruitment of a full-time **Governance Engagement Coordinator** has been **approved**. The position will complete the work necessary to initiate community engagement, consultation, development, and ratification of each core function of governance.

YOUTH LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

- Mobile Crisis Response Team (under development)
 - In collaboration with collaborating partners, Saugeen First Nation is initiating a 24/7 Response Team for Saugeen First Nation.
- Community Wellness Team (under consideration)
 - Proposal has been submitted for a Community Wellness Team comprised of a Child and Youth Worker, Addictions Nurse, Registered Social Worker, Nurse Practitioner, Traditional Healer, Chiropodist and Elder Support.
- Land-Based Healing Program (under consideration)
 - Proposal has been submitted for creation of a Land-Based Treatment Program.
