## NALOXONE TRAINING NOTICE

In consideration of our organizational commitment contributing to capacity-building, there will be Public Health Nurses (PHN's) set-up at the **Governance Building (6 Cameron Dr.)** on **Thursday March 23th. 2023**, **from 2:00 PM - 6:00 PM** and will be offering:

- 1. Naloxone and Harm Reduction training to <u>any Council member, staff member,</u> <u>or community member</u> who is interested, AND
- 2. For <u>any department interested in being a designated Naloxone distribution</u> <u>site</u>, the nurses will provide the respective Department Head with more in-depth training as to the process for distributing and reporting Naloxone distribution, AND
- 3. Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infections (STBBI) Testing

Public Health is offering the training for all Council members, staff members, and community members on a drop-in basis.

You do not require any previous experience, knowledge, or education to attend the training.

As part of our organizational commitment to increase capacity-building, <u>all</u> personnel are strongly encouraged to attend the Naloxone training.
