## SECONDARY SCHOOL BURSARY

---

Objectives:

- To publicly honor two (2) graduating Ontario secondary school students who have made significant contribution in the area of academics, community development, recreational development or technical achievement.
- Students must meet the criteria as specified by the Saugeen Education Committee.
- To distribute \$2,000 once *per* bursary or as directed by the Saugeen Education Committee.
- To encourage Saugeen's youth through the positive education experiences.
- Students may apply for both bursaries, but can only be awarded one per academic career.

The two (2) awards have been broken down into the following two (2) categories.

**1. *The Richard Kahgee Award for Excellence in Science and Technical Studies***

The student must demonstrate that he/she is an exceptional student capable of positive marks and work habits related to the field of Science and Technical education.

**Criteria for Academic Scholarship**

- Must be a band member of Saugeen First Nation.
- Successfully completed OSSD with a minimum b+ average or higher.
- Must be enrolled in a recognized college or university. **MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF ENROLLMENT.**
- Recent letter of recommendation from a principal, teacher, professor, or academic advisor from the current year, demonstrating academic achievement.

**2. *The Melvin Rote Award***

Is presented to a student who has shown recreation leadership skills either through community or extra-curricular involvement.

**Criteria for Leadership/Extra-curricular Scholarship**

- Must be a band member of Saugeen First Nation.
- Successfully completed requirements and Community Service hours for their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).
- Student has shown leadership abilities at school or in the community.
- Must be enrolled in a recognized college or university. **MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF ENROLLMENT.**
- Recent letter of recommendation from a principal, teacher, professor, or academic advisor from the current year, demonstrating academic achievement.
